Studying might not always seem relevant to your day-today life, particularly due to outdated courses and skills in this rapidly changing world. However, the truth is that if you are studying rigorously then this brings restraints and control in your life. This self-discipline is the single most important trait of successful people. In other words, their success did not come because of scoring 95% but it came because of the discipline they developed through sincere and habitual hard work. The process of studying is more important than the outcome. For most of you, studying is the most productive use of your time but if you were to engage in any other activity that in still strict discipline, you will still gain tremendous confidence and no matter what professional challenge may come in your life, you will confidently navigate it with grace and resilience. This brings me to animportant point that yourdefinition of success should not be outcome-based but rather processbased. Results are not always in your full control but the process is. For example, instead of targeting to score a certain

rank, you should focus on studying x number of hours every day. Define your success by your ability toform and sustain habits and not by results. Another important questionsome of you have is what career pursue. Unfortunately, there's no one-size-fits-all answer to this question. I have seen most students studving hard but makinguninformed career choices based mainly on external factors such as social status, salary, and peer pressure.I strongly advise students todedicate some time researching different careers/jobs and understanding their day-to-day lifestyle, responsibilities, and pros and cons. You can take career assessment tests, do internships, voluntary work, or talk to or shadow experienced professionals, or useYouTube or other online content to gain more exposure. Besides lifestyle, you should also consider practical aspectsof various career options such as the number of opportunities, earning potential, and other factors that are relevant to your personal background and personality. Knowing or discovering oneself is the mostcrucial for making the right career choice. Students must spend some alone time away from external influences of friends, social media, family, and even studying, to introspect and learn more about themselves. There are various ways to do this such as daily meditation, counseling, and various other exercises. Even if you dedicate 5 to 15 minutes of your daily time to "self-discovery", it will help your tremendously in your personal growth, career, and life in general.



Finally, I want to reassure you that no matter what path you choose, success is not defined solely by your performance in exams, college admission, or money you make. It is important to remember that your worth is not determined by external factors, but by the effort you put into becoming the best version of yourself. So, know yourself, believe in yourself, focus on developing better habits, and stay sincere in your efforts. All the best for your future career and life!







Good morning to one and all present over here, I'm Pankti Prajapati from...


Aren't those the words we used to play on the tip of our tongue, when we stood in assembly with Xavier's logo on our backs, battling performance pressure infront of our proud teachers.




