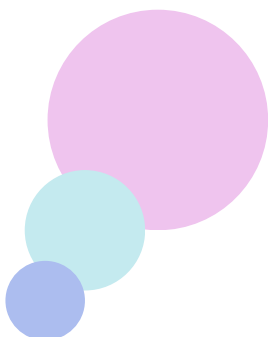
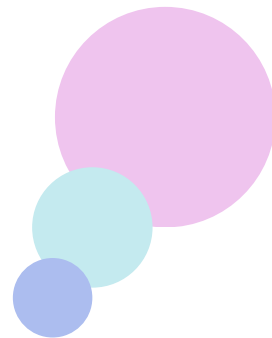

વિશ્વ ઓઝોન દિવસ

દર વર્ષે 16 સપ્ટેમ્બર ના રોજ સમગ્ર વિશ્વમાં વિશ્વ ઓઝોન દિવસ મનાવવામાં આવે છે. આ દિવસ આપણને યાદ અપાવે છે કે પૃથ્વી પરનું જીવન બચાવવા માટે ઓઝોન સ્તર કેટલું અગત્યનું છે.

ઓઝોન સ્તર પૃથ્વીના વાતાવરણના સ્ટ્રેટરોસ્ફીયરમાં આવેલું છે. તેનું કામ સુર્યમાંથી આવતી હાનિકારક અલ્ટ્રાવાયોલેટ (UV) કિરણોનું રોકવાનું છે. આ કિરણો પૃથ્વી પર સીધા પહોંચે તો મનુષ્યમાં ત્વચા કેન્સર, આંખના રોગ અને ખેતી પ્રકૃતિને ભારે નુકસાન પહોંચાડી શકે છે.

1987 માં “મોન્ટ્રિયાલ પ્રોટોકોલ” નામનો આંતરરાષ્ટ્રીય કરાર થયો, જેમાં ઓઝોનને નુકસાન કરતાં રસાયણો (CFCs) નો ઉપયોગ ઘટાડવાનો નિર્ણય લેવામાં આવ્યો હતો. આ ઐતિહાસિક નિર્ણયની યાદમાં દર વર્ષે 16 સપ્ટેમ્બરનો દિવસ “ઓઝોન દિવસ” તરીકે મનાવવામાં આવે છે.

“protecting Ozone Layer ,Protecting Climate”

અર્થાત, “ઓઝોન સ્તરની રક્ષા એટલે હવામાનની રક્ષા.”

આજના સમયમાં પ્રદૂષણ ,ગ્રીનહાઉસ ગેસ અને ઉધોગોના કારણે પ્રકૃતિ પર ભાર વધ્યો છે. આપણા નાના પ્રયત્નો જેમકે વૃક્ષારોપણ, પ્લાસ્ટિકનો ઓછો ઉપયોગ, ઉર્જા બચાવવી -ઓઝોન સ્તરને સુરક્ષિત રાખવામાં મદદરૂપ બની શકે છે.
